In early December 2004, Mammoth Hospital donated about \$23,500 worth of computer components to Jason Atkinson, Director of Technology at Mammoth High School. Approximately 18 computer processing units, 20 monitors, 28 keyboards, 20 mice, 12 printers and 40 power cords were donated for the one day computer sale held on December 11, 2005. Atkinson's main goal was to provide computers to those under privileged kids who normally would not be able to afford one. The public was able to purchase monitors as high as \$10 and computer towers as high as \$30. The extremely discounted prices enabled many of the kids at Mammoth High School the opportunity to purchase computers that normally would be out of their price range. Proceeds of this sale went back to the Mammoth High School Technology Department.
